- Plan the strategy and implement the organization's service, lead the head of functions to set and reach the KPI's,

- Serve as representative in the organization in the absence of the President (participate or attend the meeting with sponsors and other governmental official if needed)

- Excellent written and oral communication, as well as interpersonal skills, listening skills
- Broad functional and project management experience
- Excellent organizational and time management skills
- Able to work independently, take quick and right decisions and drive for deadlines
- High working proficiency in English. Knowledge of Danish is a plus

- Fundraising experience is a plus
